General Supplies for all classes:

- 3 reams of white copy paper (turned in to the office during registration or on the first day of school)

- Earbuds/headphones to use with Chromebooks when instructed

Supplies for Math, English Language Arts, Science and Social Studies:

- 1 4-inch binder
- 8 1-subject spiral notebooks* (one for each semester of Math, ELA, SS, Science)
- 4 3-hole-punch durable folders*

*Notebooks/folders should be the following colors:

- Science: green
- Social Studies: yellow
- Math: blue
- Language Arts: red
- Pencil pouch (can clip in to binder)
- Pencils with erasers
- Blue, black, red pens
- 4 highlighters
- Pack of pencils (to give to advisory teacher)
- 1 pack of 3"x5" index cards

Additional supplies for MS Language Arts:

- 1 Composition Notebook - College Ruled
- 1-inch 3-ring binder with 6 divider tabs (7th graders can use their 3-ring binders from last year, if they are in good condition; 6th graders and new students need to bring the binders and tabs)
- 2 packages of lined paper

General Supplies for all classes:

- 3 reams of copy paper (turned in to the office prior to or on the first day of school)

- Backpack
- Pencil bag

- Pens (blue or black)
- Correcting pens (red, green or purple ink work best)
- At least 2 highlighters (different colors)
- Pack of colored pencils
- Erasers
- 3-5 glue sticks
- 1 pack of 3"x5" index cards for occasional use in each class
- Earbuds/headphones to use with Chromebooks when instructed
- Paper/notebooks for each class (see specific requirements below)

MATH:

- Graph paper (1/4 inch squares)
- 1 notebook (lined or graph)
- Scientific or graphing calculator. Contact your teacher if you are considering purchasing a graphing calculator.

LANGUAGE ARTS:

- 8th-12th grade: One Weld County Library Card
- 8th-12th grade: Folder for all ELA work
- 8th-10th grade: 1-inch 3-ring binder with 6 divider tabs (Returning students can use their 3-ring binders from last year, if they are in good condition; new students need to bring the binders and tabs)
- 8th-11th grade: 2 packages of lined paper
- 8th-11th grade: paper bag for book cover (or other heavy duty cover-not fabric)
- 12th grade: 1 Composition book

SPANISH:

- 100 3"x5" index cards
- Paper bag for book cover
- Spanish 1, 2, 3, 4 and AP: 1 spiral notebook for class notes

ELECTIVES:

- AP Computer Science:** 1 3-ring binder with 8 divider tabs

SCIENCE:

- Biology: 1 notebook or composition book, and one folder
- Chemistry: 1 notebook or composition book, Scientific calculator (can be used in math class, too), and one folder
- AP Environmental Science: 1 3-ring binder, 1 composition book

ART:

- 3 black ballpoint or fine tip sharpie pens
- Plastic paint palette
- 2 brushes (1 round and 1 flat recommended)
- Small set of acrylic paints: you just need white, black, red, yellow, and blue but a small set of 12 is nice.
- Plastic cup for paint water-a clean yogurt container works well.
- Set of markers (brand is not important)
- A shoebox labeled with student's name to store all supplies
