THE TIMELINE FOR SUCCESS

ON track or **OFF** track

KEY TERMS THAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

ON Track - All classes have been passed and PSAT/SAT scores meet grade level expectations

OFF Track - One or more classes have been failed, you do not meet PSAT/SAT grade level expectations or both

IC - Infinite Campus; the number one resource for students and parents to find **On** and **Off** track information

9th Grade

: 6-7 classes per semester

: Earned 3-3.5 credits each semester

: Met PSAT benchmarks

: Revised and submitted a graduation pathway ICAP to the counselor and/or Principal

11th Grade

: 6-7 classes per semester

: Earned 3-3.5 credits each semester

: Met SAT benchmarks

: Revised and submitted a graduation pathway ICAP to the counselor and/or Principal

12th Grade

: Passed all classes from 9th-11th grade

: Earned at least 18 credits at the beginning of the 12th grade year

: Final revision and submitted ICAP to ensure on time graduation

Postsecondary credits can be earned through completion of Aims Community College courses (each 3+ credit hour is equivalent to 0.5 UCPS credits) or through completion of Advanced Placement® courses provided by UCPS. Students must meet UCPS's Concurrent Enrollment eligibility guidelines in order to enroll in Aims courses.*
